An Overview of Using Press'n Seal

Below is an overview of my approach to creating a bra sloper mold for custom-fit bras using Glad's Press'n Seal wrap. These photos are taken from the video demonstrating this technique for my online class "How to Make Custom-Fit Bras."

 Press'n Seal is applied directly to the skin. My model is wearing "Smooth 'em nipple concealers" from Pure Style, LLC.



2. Cut the Press'n Seal into strips. The width of the strip depends on the size of the breast. The strips shown here are 2" (5cm) wide.



3. Apply the strips first to the rib cage then the breast. In this photo the breast is being sculpted into the desired shape.



4. You can see how the breast has been shaped.



5. After the Press'n Seal has been applied, reinforce it with masking tape.



Cover the body from above the bust to the rib with masking tape.



7. Cover from center front to center back.



8. After the masking tape is applied, draw in the lines for the bra sloper.



9. The final step is to carefully remove the Press'n Seal from the body.
